- C. Swimmers requiring attention to raise their arm above water in straight line to sky.

Hazards to Keep a Lookout For:

- A. Weather/Wind changes can occur very quickly.
- B. Rocks, submerged trees and other water borne debris if swimming close to shore.
- C. Fences that continue from land out into the water.
- D. Water temperature (cold) and conditions (waves may impact breathing).
- E. Marine life if swimming in the sea.
- F. Other Swimmers

Incident Reporting:

Any health and safety incidents to be reported to competition organisers (refer below for contact details).

Post-Competition De-Brief:

The organising committee will conduct a safety debrief after the event to review competition safety. Your feedback regarding how we might improve the safety of future events is welcome.
