## Conditions of entry:

- ⇒ **The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand regulations with specific conditions and criteria:**
- ⇒ Entry limit of 4 individual events per swimmer
- ⇒ Age as at 20 August 2011.
- ⇒ Over the top starts will apply
- ⇒ All swimmers must report to the marshalling area at least 4 heats prior to their event (50m events 6 heats)
- ⇒ Warm up 40 minutes – Lanes 1 & 8 sprint lanes for the last 20 minutes
- ⇒ Entry fee: \$4 per individual event, and \$6 per relay team. Swimmers must be affiliated to Swimming Southland for the 2011/12 season. Visitors affiliated to Swimming New Zealand welcome. Swimmers' will compete in the mixed gender events as scheduled above and results will be published in the following age groupings and gender. 10 & U, 11/12, 13/14 & 15 & O. Please note that Swimming Southland has recently passed a rule that allows Swimming Southland records to be broken in mixed gender events. However Swimming NZ records cannot be broken in mixed gender events and other provinces records may not be allowed. Please communicate with the Swimming Southland Executive Officer prior to the meet should you believe this affects any swimmers.
- ⇒ Entry into the 400m IM and 400m freestyle events is reserved for swimmers who are in regular training and who have coach support to do so. Swimming Southland reserves the right to refuse an entry where it is felt the swimmer will be too far behind the general standard of the competition. Subject to this, no more than two heats of swimmers will compete in each event.

- ⇒ NT (No times) accepted for all events
- ⇒ Events 21,22 and 23 are club relay events for mixed teams. Each team must contain at least 1 male or 1 female. Clubs may join together and enter teams where they do not have enough swimmers available. These teams are to be entered manually by email with the Swimming Southland Executive Officer.  
Swimmer may swim up an age group. All clubs must supply the names of the swimmers involved
- ⇒ Cash prize for Swimmer of each meet awarded by the selectors. (see below)
- ⇒ Random participation cash prize draw awarded at based on event number and placing. (see below)
- ⇒ Random participation cash prize draw awarded to a swimmer who attends all three Winter meets. (see below)
- ⇒ Each swimmers PBs will be accumulated across all three Winter meets and the swimmer with the largest total will win a cash prize. (see below)

**Participation Prize Draws**

A cash prize of \$20 will be awarded to a swimmer based on a random draw of event number and placing – anyone can win this prize.

A cash prize of \$50 will be awarded to a swimmer who competes in all three Winter meets. All swimmers who attend all three meets will be entered into the draw. These prizes will be awarded at the first available opportunity.

**PB Prize Draw**

A cash prize of \$50 will be awarded to the swimmer who accumulates the greatest number of PBs (as compared to their entry times) across all of the three Winter meets. If a tie exists the prizemoney will be shared evenly. Swimmers entering an event with a NT will not be awarded a PB for the sake of this award. This prize will be awarded at the first available opportunity.

**Swimmer of the Meet**

A cash prize of \$30 will be awarded to the “Swimmer of the Meet”. This will be determined by the Swimming Southland selectors and will be awarded at the first available opportunity.
