Policy: **Swimming Southland Records**
Objective: **To ensure Swimming Southland Records are achieved fairly and recorded accurately**

1. Swimming Southland Records may only be broken at 'official' swimming meet. A meet is deemed official if it has met Swimming New Zealand's 'Meet Approval Process' (see below for this document)
2. Records shall be recognised to 100th (one hundredth) of a second.
3. Records can only be validated if swum in a surveyed, still water swimming pool.
4. Notification of a record must be submitted to Swimming Southland within the current season. (Swimming Southland Executive Officer will endeavour to submit all records on behalf of the swimmers)
5. The Swimming Southland Board shall consider all records submitted within a timely manner. The Swimming Southland Board may pre-approve record performances via email, prior to the next scheduled board meeting, in order to recognise the record in a timely manner. A formal ratification is to be made at the next board meeting.
6. Swimming Southland's website includes a current list of Southland Record Holders, ratified by the Board of Swimming Southland.
