21. **WAVERLEY SKINS EVENT - 12 years & Under
- 13 years & Over**

The **Waverley Skins Event** is an exciting series of consecutive races, using the following criteria and format;

- There will be two separate events in the following age groups; 12 years & Under / 13 years & Over
- The fastest 8 swimmers (mixed gender) in each of the above age groups will be selected by a calculation of PB's swum in events 1 and 5 (50m Free and 50m Back)
- Any swimmer not wishing to be considered for selection, please let the control room know by the completion of event 5.
- 12 & Under event – will be 50m Free, 50m Breast, 50m Back, 50m Free
- 13 & Over event – will be 50m Fly, 50m Breast, 50m Back, 50m Free
- Swimmers will remain in their allocated lane for the duration of the race
- Each race/lap will be swum consecutively, with a 1.00 minute interval in between each lap (timing started from Referee's whistle) – the next lap will start whether the swimmer is on the blocks or not.
- The slowest 2 swimmers of each lap will be eliminated, leaving 2 swimmers racing it out in the final lap!
- The aim of this exciting event is stamina!
- **Prizes!!!**

The winner of each age group event (12 & Under, 13 & Over) will receive a \$250 SwimT3 voucher

Conditions of entry:

- This meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand regulations with specific conditions and criteria in accordance with FINA and SNZ rules
- In line with Swimming New Zealand's updated 'Right to Compete' by-law – all 50m and longer distance events are open to both club and competitive swimmers who are current, financial and registered with SNZ for the current year (this means both club and competitive swimmers will swim in the same events).

25m events are reserved for Learn to Swim swimmers only – these are fun/have a go races.

– No Entry Fee for these 25m Have A Go races

- Age as at 6th May 2018
- The meet will be swum SHORT COURSE (25m) as timed mixed finals and with over the top starts
- The warm up shall be 40 minutes commencing at 2.00pm – Lanes 1 & 8 dive lanes for the last 20 minutes
- All swimmers must report to the marshalling area at least 4 heats prior to their event (25m events, 6 heats)
- There is no restriction on the number of entries per swimmer
- All 50m, 100m and 200m events shall be resulted male and female into the following age groups – 10 & under, 11/12 years, 13/14 years and 15 years and over
- All 400m events shall be resulted as male and female open.
- Entries with no times will be accepted – however coaches discretion required
- Spectators Pool Entry – please be aware that there is a fee for spectators when entering Splash Palace.
