Meet Conditions:

- This Meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand regulations with specific conditions and criteria.
- The meet is Short Course and will run as timed finals, with over the top starts
- Swimmers will compete in the mixed gender events as scheduled above and results will be published in the following age groupings and gender; 10yrs & under, 11 - 12 yrs., 13 -14 yrs. and 15yrs & over.
- In line with Swimming New Zealand's 'Right to Compete' by-law – all events are open to both club and competitive swimmers who are current, financial and registered with SNZ for the current year.
- NT (no times) accepted for all events and Swimming Southland encourage 'Have a Go' swimmers to enter this FUN meet.
- Entry into the distance events ((400m Free, 400m IM, 800m & 1500m Free) is reserved for the swimmers who are in regular training and who have coach support to do so. Swimming Southland reserves the right to refuse an entry where it is felt the swimmer will be too far behind the general standard of the competition. Subject to this, no more than two heats of swimmers will compete in each event, and where possible these events may be combined.
- All swimmers must report to marshalling a minimum of 4 heats prior to their event (6 heats for 25m/50m).
- Warm up 45 minutes – Lanes 1 & 8 dive and sprint lanes for the last 20 minutes.
- Please note that Swimming Southland has a rule that allows Swimming Southland records to be broken in mixed gender events. However Swimming NZ records cannot be broken in mixed gender events and other regions records may not be ratified. Please communicate with the Swimming Southland Executive Officer prior to the meet should you believe this affects any swimmers.
- Events 21 and 22 are Club Relay Events for mixed teams. Each team must contain at least 1 Male and 1 Female. Clubs may join together and enter teams where they do not have enough swimmers available.

- Spectators Pool Entry – please be aware, there is a fee for spectators when entering Splash Palace payable on entry

Entries

- Entry age is as at July 31st 2021 & there is an entry limit of 6 individual events per swimmer per meet
- Entry fee \$8.00 per event per swimmers . Relays \$13.00 per team
- **Competitive swimmers** must enter via the SNZ online system by 11.59pm on Wednesday July 21st
- **Have a go entries** must be emailed to Development@swimsouthland.org.nz by 5pm Tuesday July 20th
- Late entries and changes after the closing date will NOT BE ACCEPTED

Prizes

The following prizes will be awarded for each of the 3 Meets

- King & Queen of the Meet (male & female swimmer 13yrs & Over) = \$30.00 each
- Prince & Princess of the Meet (male & female swimmer 12yrs & Under) = \$30.00 each
- Plus 1 random prize per Meet
- All swimmers gaining a 'personal best' time (from the entry seed time), will receive a PB ribbon. All ribbons will be collated after the meet by club for team managers to present to their swimmers
- All prizes and ribbons will be handed out at the next meet
