Meet Prizes

Cash Rewards

FINA point prize - \$100 will be awarded to the Male & Female with the most FINA points for 1 event
NZ Age Group Records – \$200 will be awarded to swimmers who break a NZ Age Group Record
Southland Records - \$100 will be awarded to swimmers who break a Southland Record

Handicap Race Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to 1st (\$100), 2nd (\$50) & 3rd (\$30) in each final

Age Group Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to 1st (\$30), 2nd (\$20) & 3rd (\$10), in each age group (male and female)

Personal Best Lucky Prize Draws

Every swimmer's Personal Best will go in a draw for \$50

Any swimmer who gains 3 Personal Best's will go into an additional draw for \$50

Once results are confirmed, we will be in touch with winners regarding payment

Meet Conditions

- The meet is Long Course and will run as timed finals, with over the top starts
- Swimmers will compete in the events as scheduled above & results will be published in the following age group and gender; Under 10 years, 11 - 12 years, 13 – 14 years, & 15 & Over
- This meet is open to all currently registered financial members of Swimming NZ & no times will be accepted for all events

Entries

- Entry fee: \$9.50 per event per swimmer
- Entries restricted to 6 events per swimmer
- Competitive swimmers must enter via the Fastlane by 11.59pm Tuesday Nov 3rd 2021
- Late entries and changes after the closing date will NOT BE ACCEPTED
- Swimmer and Spectator pool entry fee - payable on entry
- No refunds for any withdrawals will be given once entries close. Medical withdrawals can be considered if a signed medical certificate is supplied prior to the commencement of the competition

Event 22 Mixed 100m Backstroke Handicap

Event 24 Mixed 100m Butterfly Handicap

Event 23 Mixed 100m Breaststroke Handicap

Event 25 Mixed 100m Freestyle Handicap

- Up to 8 swimmers to compete in four 100m handicap races
- The 2 fastest males & females from 13 & Under & 14 & Over age groups from the appropriate 100m Back, Breast, Fly & Free events (4, 5, 9, 10, 12, 13, 17 & 18)
- One final per stroke and per swimmer
- Swimmers qualifying for handicap events will be entered in the first event they qualify for. If the first 1 or 2 swimmers in each 100m event have already qualified for a handicap race then the next place-getter will qualify until all spots are filled
- Handicaps will be based on personal bests

Technical Officials & Volunteers

- Duty Sheets - accessible on the Swimming Southland website (local meets information section)
- Note, this is a shared document via Google Drive therefore the names showing are filled positions

Team Managers Information

- All Team Managers MUST be Police Vetted as per Swimming NZ Member Protection policy.
- Clubs are required to notify the Swimming Southland Executive Officer as to whom their designated managers are for this meet by Wednesday Nov 10th 2021
- Managers must wear their Swimming Southland ID cards
- Disqualifications will be announced (when possible)
- A copy of the DQ form will available from the Control Room
- Results will be posted as soon as possible, glass windows of the café at the shallow end of the main pool
- Swimming Southland will have live results via Meet Mobile
- Finalised Session results will be published on the Swimming Southland website by 5pm Monday Nov 15th
- Team Managers are asked to ensure athletes do not procure additional seats

Competition Documents

- Draft reports will be placed on SS website and emailed to competitors and clubs on Thursday Nov 4th
- Corrections are to be emailed to Swimming Southland no later than noon Monday Nov 8th
- Final Psych Sheets will be published on the Swimming Southland website on Wednesday Wed 10th
- The Program & Seating Plan will be published on the Swimming Southland website no later than 5:00pm, Friday Nov 12th - there will be NO programs available for purchase at this competition

Extra Information

- All swimmers must report to marshaling at least 4 heats prior to their event
- Please note that Swimming Southland has a rule that allows Swimming Southland records to be broken in mixed gender events. However Swimming NZ records cannot be broken in mixed gender events and other regions records may not be ratified. Please communicate with the Swimming Southland Executive Officer prior to the meet should you believe this affects any swimmers
- Photographs taken during the meet may be used by Swimming Southland website and/or Murihiku Swimming Club, please make the Executive Officer aware if you do not wish your photograph to be used admin@swimsouthland.org.nz

- Warmup is to be conducted under the consultation and guidance of all coaches
- Dive lanes (1&8) & Pace lanes (2&7) will at 2:20pm, with 30 minutes of warmup remaining
- The Learners Pool will be available for warmup / down during racing

Health & Safety Requirements

Supervision Policy

- Athletes who are 6 years & under must wear a yellow arm band and athletes 7 years & under must wear a green band. Bands CAN be removed for racing but MUST be worn at all other times. Athletes are able to make their own way to marshaling and start blocks. Upon completion of their race make their way back to their seat in the grandstand
- Athletes using the warmup and down pool during the competition MUST be supervised at all times

Pool Deck

- During the competition, only essential personal (Technical Officials and Timekeepers) are allowed on the pool deck
- Coaches are to remain in their designated area at all times

General

- Be careful in the Grandstand, it can get very slippery
- Fire exits, and clearways are always to remain clear
- Evacuation Procedure: if the pool requires evacuation you will be guided by Splash Palace Pool staff, please remain calm and their follow instructions
