Meet Conditions

- The meet is Short Course and will run as timed finals (hand timing), with over the top starts (5 lanes)
- This meet is open to all currently registered financial members of Swimming NZ, and entries with no times will be accepted – however coaches discretion required
- The Bluff Swimming Club encourages 'Have a Go' swimmers to enter & NT (no times) will be accepted. Times gained at the meet will not be recognised by Swimming NZ.
- Swimmers will compete in the mixed gender events as scheduled above & results will be published in the following age groupings and gender; 10 & under, 11/12years, 13/14years and 15years and over.

Club Relays

- Club relay events are for mixed teams and each team must contain at least 1 Male and 1 Female.
- Clubs may join together and enter teams where they do not have enough swimmers available.
- Swimmers may swim up an age group, but not in two age groups.

Entries

- Entry age is as at 13th Feb 2022
- Entry fee \$8.50 per event per swimmers and \$10 per Club Relay
- There is no restriction on the number of entries per swimmer
- **Have a go entries** must be emailed to Development@swimsouthland.org.nz by 12.00pm **Monday Jan 31st**
- **Competitive swimmers** must enter via Fastlane by 11.59pm on **Tuesday Feb 1st**
- Late entries and changes after the closing date will NOT BE ACCEPTED
- No refunds for any withdrawals will be given once entries close. Medical withdrawals can be considered if a signed medical certificate is supplied prior to the commencement of the competition
- There will be no Swimmer pool entry fee

Competition Documents

- Draft reports will placed on our website and emailed to competitors and clubs on Thursday Feb 3rd
- Corrections are to be emailed to Swimming Southland no later than 12pm Tuesday Feb 8th
- Final Psych Sheets will be emailed to swimmers on Wednesday Feb 9th
- The Meet Program & Seating Plan will be published on the Swimming Southland website no later than 5pm, Thursday Feb 10th
- There will be NO programs available for purchase at this competition

Extra Information

- There will be Spot Prizes up for grabs during the meet
- All swimmers must report to marshaling at least 4 heats prior to their event
- Please note that Swimming Southland has a rule that allows Swimming Southland records to be broken in mixed gender events. However Swimming NZ records cannot be broken in mixed gender events and other regions records

may not be ratified. Please communicate with the Swimming Southland Executive Officer prior to the meet should you believe this affects any swimmers

- Warmup is to be conducted under the consultation and guidance of all coaches
- Warm up 4 minutes – Lanes 1 & 5 sprint lanes for the last 20 minutes
- Seating is be limited and therefore we are advising adults to bring along their own camp chair on the day
- Spectators – please be aware that there is a \$2 fee for spectators when entering the pool

Team Managers Information

- All Team Managers MUST be Police Vetted as per Swimming NZ Member Protection policy.
- Clubs are required to notify Swimming Southland as to whom their **designated Managers** are for this meet by **Wednesday Feb 9th**
- Designated Managers must wear their Swimming Southland ID cards at the meet

Disqualifications

- Disqualifications will be announced (when possible).
- A copy of the DQ form will available from the Pool Office

Results

- Posted as soon as possible, glass windows of the café at the shallow end of the main pool
- Finalised results will be published on the Swimming Southland website by 5pm Monday Feb 14th
